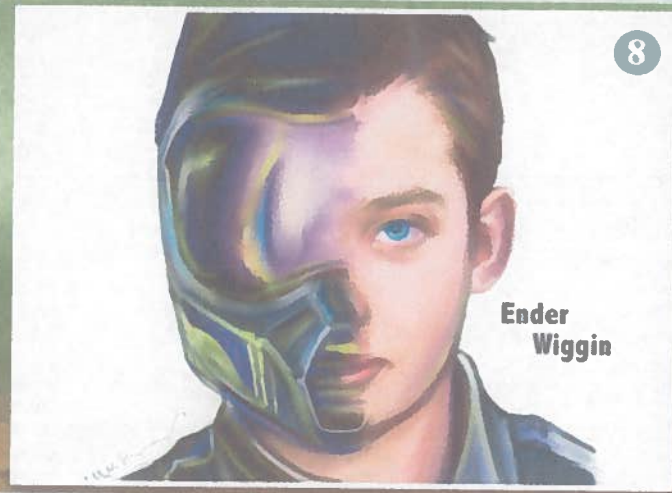

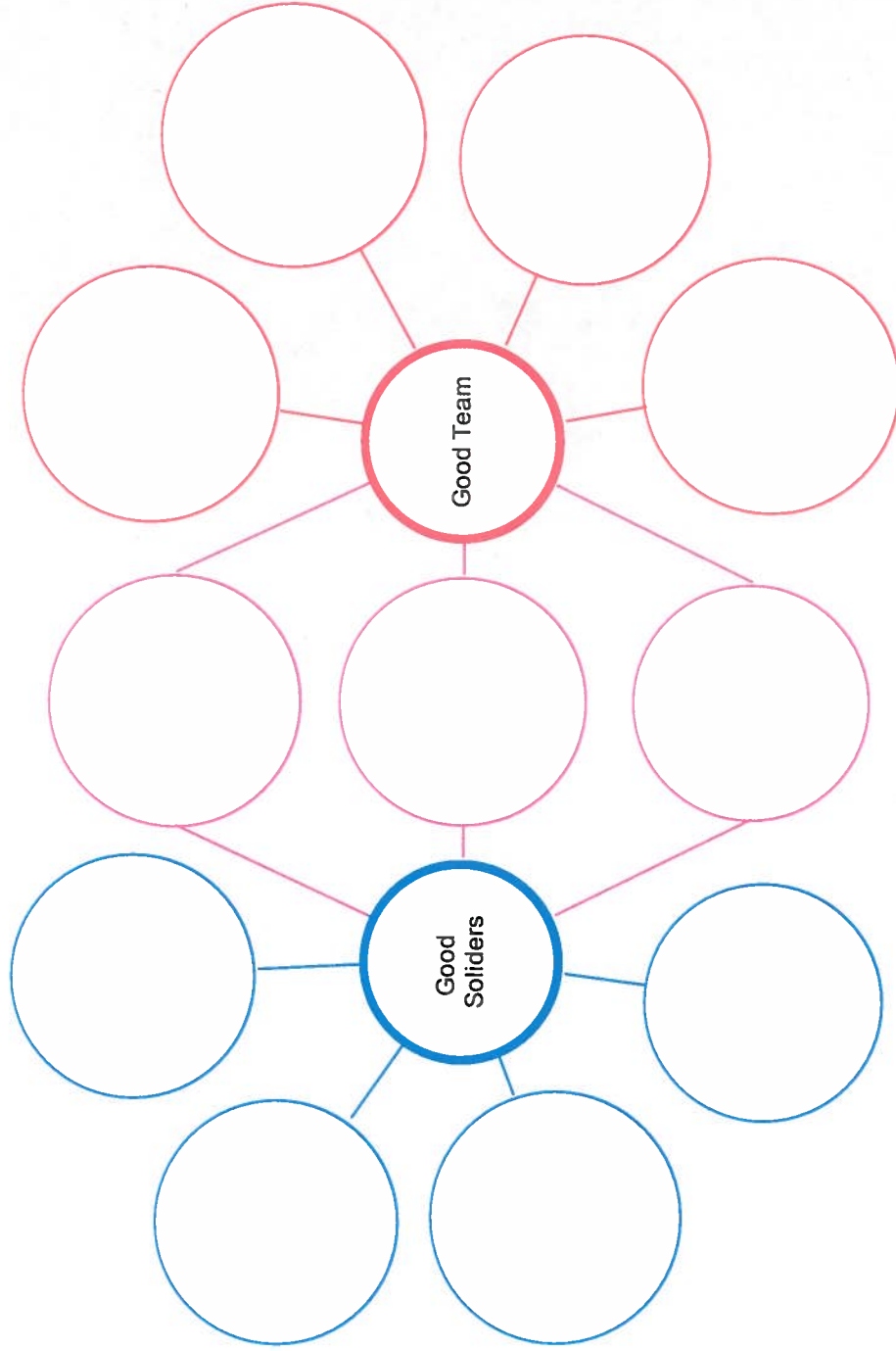

3. What could you or your group have done better? How did communication play a key role in the success (or failure) of your tower?



8 Methods of Characterization

You are going to use what you know about Valentine to fill out the 8 methods of characterization. Make sure you answer questions in COMPLETE sentences or you will not get credit for it.

1. Physical Description: Draw what you think Valentine looks like.



2. Name Analysis: Write why you think Orson Scott Card chose the name Valentine for her character. How does the name reflect who she is?

3. Attitude/Appearance: Write how you think Valentine feels about kids being recruited for battle school.

4. Dialogue: Write a quote of something Valentine says and explain what this reveals about her as a person.

5. Thoughts: In Chapter 9 p.88-89 we get to read Valentine's mind. What do her thoughts reveal about what she thinks of Peter?

6. Reactions of Others: Based on how Valentine is treated by Peter. Do you think Peter likes or dislikes Valentine? Explain your reasoning.

7. Action or Incident: How does Valentine becoming Demosthenes affect her character? In other words how does it change her?

8. Physical Setting: How does the physical world that Valentine lives in shape who she is becoming as a character?

Emotional Setting: How does the emotional stress of having a brother like Peter affect Valentine?
